may have some complex features, may be electronic or battery operated, may require some training to learn how to use and are more expensive

Hi Tech

the most complex devices or equipment, that have digital or electronic components, may be computerized, will likely require training and effort to learn how to use and cost the most.






Table Extender Using PVC



Awkward positioning increases pressure on medial nerve and other structures in and around wrist




No More Injections!!!

(diabetes, fear of needles....)



- Pills will painlessly inject drugs into the lining of the stomach
- Each capsule contains several tiny injectors or "Nano Needles"
- Pills self-right on floor of the stomach
- At the base of the needle is a compressed spring held in place by sugar. When the sugar dissolves in the stomach, the needle is fired down into lining
- Technology proven to be effective on animals, but to date has not been tested on humans
